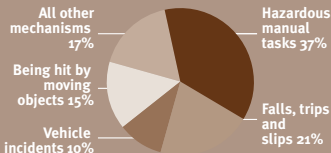


Transport



What's causing the injuries?



Which subsector?

Three in every five transport claims are from the road transport subsector.



Which age group?

One in four injuries in transport affect workers aged between 45 and 54 years.

How many workplace incidents?

3,800
incidents

There are 3,800 general workplace injuries in transport a year, affecting one in every 35 transport workers. One in every 70 workers suffers a serious injury.

How many workplace deaths?



Approximately 11 transport workers die each year as a result of a workplace injury.

At what cost?



On average, \$18,000 is paid out for each claim in the transport sector.

Workdays lost?



In transport, 61 days are lost for injuries needing time off work, compared to 48 days for all industries.
