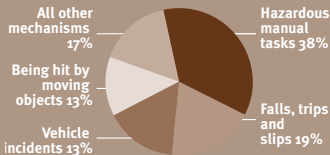


Transport

One in two claims are from the road transport subsector.



Which age group?

One in four injuries in transport affect workers aged between 45 and 54 years.

How many workplace incidents?

4,500
incidents

There are 4,500 general workplace injuries in transport a year, affecting one in every 30 transport workers. One in every 60 workers suffers a serious injury.

How many workplace deaths?



Approximately three transport workers die each year as a result of a workplace injury.

At what cost?



Around \$58 million is paid out annually for transport workers' compensation claims.

Workdays lost?



In transport, 52 days are lost for injuries needing time off work, compared to 43 days for all industries.
