Respiratory health and workers' compensation information for former Queensland mine and quarry workers



What is a respiratory health assessment?

A respiratory health assessment includes:

- a respiratory questionnaire
- a chest x-ray that is dual read to the ILO classification by certified B-readers
- lung function testing
- a referral to a respiratory specialist and HRCT, if required.

Your travel costs to attend this assessment may be covered.

How do I check my eligibility?

Contact the Coal Mine Workers' Health Scheme to check your eligibility, and apply for your assessment on:

What if I am diagnosed?

Take action. Support and treatment is available.

If you are diagnosed with a mine dust lung disease you may be entitled to workers' compensation.

How do I apply for compensation?

As soon as possible contact your insurer with:

- a copy of any medical reports
- a medical certificate issued by your GP.

You can ask for your respiratory health assessment results under the Coal Mine Workers' Health Scheme to be sent to your insurer.

What are my entitlements?

- Weekly compensation.
- Medical and related expenses including counselling.
- Lump sum compensation.
- An additional lump sum may apply if diagnosed with pneumoconiosis.
- Return to work assistance and pulmonary rehabilitation expenses.
- Travel expenses.
