Variation to an Enforceable Undertaking between the Workplace Health and Safety Regulator and M.E Christensen & Co Pty Ltd (MEC), accepted on 17 December 2018

The following variation to the Enforceable Undertaking between the regulator and MEC is proposed:

Remove from EU:

- Term 3.2.11 - Commence Vocational Education and Training (VET) sector training from Registered Training Organisations (RTO):
 - 2 employees will complete a Certificate 4 in Engineering with an emphasis on safety in the workplace and act as mentors and safety leaders.
 - 3 employees will complete a Certificate 3 in Engineering with an emphasis on safety in the workplace.

Minimum cost: \$15,000

Under:

- Term 3.2.1 - Engage a Workplace Health and Safety Manager (WHS) to manage the EU and the compliance of the commitments (\$59,280 per year of the EU) – Minimum Cost \$177,840:
 - For - (\$59,280 per year of the EU) – Minimum Cost \$177,840
 - Increase costs to - (\$64,280 per year of the EU) – Minimum Cost \$192,840
