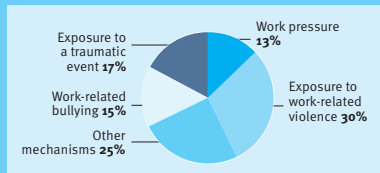


# Work-related mental disorders

## What are the causes?



## Which age group?



More than two in every five mental disorder workers' compensation claims are made by female workers aged between 25 and 54 years.

## Which industry?



Over a quarter of accepted mental disorder claims are for workers in health care and social assistance.

## How many workplace incidents?



On average, **1,900 serious mental disorder claims** are accepted in Queensland each year.

## At what cost?



**\$113 million is paid out** annually for accepted mental disorder workers' compensation claims. Mental disorder claims typically cost around \$48,400 per claim on average, compared to \$23,900 for all other serious claims.

## Workdays lost?



**Typically, 127 days are lost** for individuals experiencing work-related mental disorders compared to 68 days lost for all other serious workers' compensation claims.

## Which occupation?



**Prison and security officers, fire fighters, police, and health and welfare support workers** have the highest incidence rate of accepted mental disorder claims.

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
