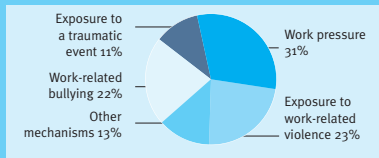


Work-related mental disorders

What are the causes?



Which age group?



Workers aged 40 years or older are more likely to be compensated for a mental disorder claim than younger workers.

Which industry?



Over a quarter of accepted mental disorder claims are for workers in health care and social assistance.

How many workplace incidents?



On average, **871 serious mental disorder claims** are accepted in Queensland each year.

At what cost?



\$43 million is paid out annually for accepted mental disorder workers' compensation claims.

Workdays lost?



Typically, 85 days are lost for individuals experiencing work-related mental disorders compared to 24 days lost for **all other** serious workers' compensation claims.

Which occupation?



Health and welfare support workers, defence force members, fire fighters and police have the highest incidence rate of accepted mental disorder claims.
