A trainer delivering HSR training on behalf of an RTO is required to be authorised by WHSQ to deliver the training. The provider will seek approval from WHSQ for trainers to conduct training through them. Requests are made to whstraining@oir.qld.gov.au and include information that supports validation of requirements listed in condition 20 of the conditions. WHSQ is to notify providers that the trainers have been approved before trainers undertake any training activities. For more information refer to the conditions.
