Primary Industries Health and Safety Partnership via University of Queensland (UQ) – Farm Safety Systems

Replace with:

Sugar Research Australia Limited will participate in James Cook University's 'Smartcane BMP' (Best Practice Management) advisory group focussing on Workplace Health and Safety in the cane industry.

And for Timeframe:

Within 24 months of acceptance of the Undertaking

Replace:

24 months with 31 months

And

Under term 3.4 - Activities to be undertaken to promote the objects of the Acts that will deliver benefits to community

For term 3.4a:

Primary Industries Health and Safety Partnership via University of Queensland (UQ) – Farmer Communication

Replace with:

SRA will disseminate the findings of the 'Smart Cane BMP' advisory group research outcomes from term 3.3a and a generic factsheet to the wider farming community via the Rural eSafe and Qld Farmers Federation publications. The research outcomes and generic factsheet will be provided to WHSQ Agricultural unit for comment prior to publication.

And for Timeframe:

Within 24 months of acceptance of the Undertaking

Replace:

24 months with 34 months
