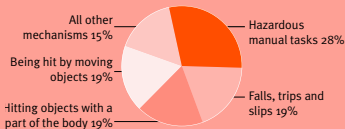

Nearly one in two claims in construction are for technicians and trades workers.



Which age group?

One in three injuries in construction affect workers aged between 25 and 34 years

How many workplace incidents?

8,000
incidents

There are 8,000 general workplace injuries in construction a year, affecting one in every 30 construction workers. One in every 75 workers suffers a serious injury.

How many workplace deaths?



Approximately eight construction workers die each year as a result of a workplace injury.

At what cost?



Around \$104 million is paid out annually for construction workers' compensation claims.

Workdays lost?



In construction, 58 days are lost for injuries needing time off work, compared to 43 days for all industries.
