What's causing the injuries?



Which jobs?

Nearly one in two claims in construction are for technicians and trades workers.

Which age group?

One in three injuries in construction affect male workers aged between 25 and 34 years.

How many workplace incidents?



There are 7,600 general workplace injuries in construction a year, affecting one in every 30 construction workers. One in every 70 workers suffers a serious injury.

How many workplace deaths?



Approximately five construction workers die each year as a result of a workplace injury.

At what cost?



Around \$16,500 is paid out for each construction workers' compensation claim.

Workdays lost?



In construction, 62 days are lost for injuries needing time off work, compared to 48 days for all industries.
