Under '3.3.6a' 'Benefit to workers...Setup and launch a Rexel Electrical Supplies Safety Program (Rexel Safety Program)':

For:

- Develop a Rexel based Hazard Identification training package to assist workers in identifying hazards and near misses.
 - Within 18 months from acceptance of this undertaking.
 - Estimated cost for the training package is \$4000

Replace:

'18 months' with '21 months'

And for:

- Workers to be trained on the Rexel Hazard Identification training package via class room settings, one on one or eLearning'.
 - Within 21 months from acceptance of this undertaking.
 - Estimated cost for the training is \$4000

Replace:

21 months with '23 months'
